## **Northern Kentucky Volunteer Lawyers (NKVL)**

### **WHAT IS IT?**

Northern Kentucky Volunteer Lawyers (NKVL) is a non-profit organization that provides legal advice and representation to low-income residents of Northern Kentucky with non-criminal problems. All legal work is performed by private attorneys who volunteer to help NKVL's clients for no fee. Although legal help is free, clients are expected to pay for court costs (for example, filing fees) if necessary in their cases. NKVL is co-sponsored by Legal Aid of the Bluegrass and the Northern Kentucky Bar Association.

### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE?**

You may be eligible for free legal services through NKVL if you live in Kenton, Campbell, Boone, Grant, Gallatin, Carroll, Owen or Pendleton counties and have very limited income and assets. NKVL can only represent people whose income and assets meet our financial guidelines.

### **WHAT CASES DO THEY HANDLE?**

Civil cases (not criminal) such as evictions, divorce, domestic violence, bankruptcy, wills, simple probate, consumer disputes, home foreclosures, unemployment compensation, immigration, SSI, non-profit corporation, tax, pension problems and special education. NKVL also runs a Pro Se or "do it yourself" divorce clinic for people seeking divorce who have no minor children, and no property or spousal support issues in dispute.

### **HOW DO YOU REACH THE NKVL**
